- 1 Dry Leaf may not be consumed this way by MMJ Patients
- 3 Form of administering MMJ that is virtually odorless and is often less harsh on the lungs than smoking
- 7 April is the Awareness Month for this PA MMJ qualifying condition
- 8 Strains that produce relaxation, sometimes to the point of "couch lock"
- 11 A patient who is a minor child or is unable to get to a dispensary for their MMJ can have someone register for this type of PA MMJ card to assist them

- 9 Often called Bud or Flower, this form of MMJ was approved by PA in August 2018
- 10 A cutting from a vegetative MMJ plant
- 12 Cure began serving patients in 2010 in this State
- 15 MMJ has been used to help many movement disorders, including this qualifying condition
- 16 Strains known for energizing, uplifting effects
- 20 In November 2018 Cure began serving patients in this city
